History...

- Ancient-Greece choruch fostered the priestesses.
- Hippocrates gave tips about nutrition, administration of fluids, compresses.
- In Rome, before christ military hospitals cherished slaves
- In 529, the first monastery was founded by St. Benedict at Monte Cassino, where monks nursed the sick.
- At the beginning of the eighteenth
 T. Flieduer began training in the theory and practice of nursing.
- 1860 the first school of nursing at the Hospital of St. Thomas in London



History

- In 1895, the first nursing school in Poland-Lviv School of Nursing
- In the years 1918-1939, has intensified efforts to develop professional practice and education of nurses
- In 1968, the Ministry of Health approved the system of specialization in nursing
- 1971 Master's degree

Training of nurses in Poland

- 1. The nurse obtained qualifications after completing nursing school.
- 2. School nursing is a college of education for the nursing program at:
 - first degree;
 - second degree.
 - others

Bachelor of Nursing

- 3 years- 4600 hours of:
- training, including clinical training is at least half, and theoretical training of at least one third dimension of education;
- shorter than three years complete a secondary school, leaving certificate and medical school or post-secondary school or college,

Master of nursing

- no less than four semesters.
- Number of hours should not be less than 1300. Number of ECTS credits should not be less than 120

Graduates have skills: the use of advanced knowledge in the area of health sciences and nursing, provision of personalized care in nursing, organize and supervise nursing care

post-graduate education:

- specialized training "specialization";
- qualifying course;
- specialized courses;
- refresher course.

- Qualification course aims to achieve by the nurse knowledge and skills to provide certain health care services within the scope of the field of nursing or applicable in the field of health care.
- A further training course aims to deepen and update their knowledge and skills nurses

responsibilities of nurses

- 1) identifying the conditions and health care needs of the patient;
- 2) identify patient care problems;
- 3) planning and performing the nursing care of the patient;
- 4) a separate award in the specified range of benefits of preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic and medical rehabilitation and recovery operations;
- 5) The execution of orders in the medical diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation;
- 6) deciding the nature and extent of care and nursing services;
- 7) health **education** and **health promotion**.



Nurse system of emergency







The method used in this study is a diagnostic survey by his "competence and job satisfaction of employees Hospital Emergency Wards in a comparative Polish countries and Turkey."


