The chain-of-benefit for a diagnostic procedure




In order for a diagnostic procedure to benefit a patient, every single one of the above chain links must remain intact. If any link fails, the chain is broken and the procedure won't help the patient.

To illustrate this chain, let's walk through the links individually. We will use bronchoscopy and Swan-Ganz catheterization as illustrations, because these are classic examples of critical care procedures. However, these principles apply to any diagnostic procedure.

IBCC chapter: VT storm

Ventricular tachycardia (VT) storm refers to recurrent episodes of VT. Although any individual episode of VT can be broken, the overall process of recurrent arrests (or ICD shocks) creates a vicious cycle. Aggressive management is required including intubation, deep sedation, antiarrhythmics, and sympatholysis. Given the rarity of this condition, it's difficult to obtain high-level evidence or extensive experience. This chapter attempts to create an organized pathway, incorporating some emerging evidence regarding ultrasoundguided stellate ganglion blocks.
