The European Society for Emergency Medicine (EuSEM) incorporates a federation which currently includes 28 European national societies of Emergency Medicine and represents more than 12,000 emergency physicians in Europe.



WHAT IS EMERGENCY MEDICINE?

Emergency Medicine is a specialty based on the knowledge and skills required for the prevention, diagnosis and management of urgent and emergency aspects of illness and injury ... in which time is critical.

The practice of Emergency Medicine encompasses the pre-hospital and in-hospital triage, resuscitation, initial assessment and management of undifferentiated urgent and emergency cases.

It also includes involvement in the development of pre-hospital and in-hospital emergency medical systems.



 - ✓ new independent, medical discipline
 - ✓ new academic discipline
 - ✓ new speciality for doctors and nurses

- system organiser
 - ✓ local Self-Government
- system supervisors

- system support

Medical Emergency Teams

P (Basic)

2 person: two paramedics or paramedic and nurse system






Medical Emergency Teams

ambulances type S (Specialist)

 minimum of 3 persons authorized to perform medical rescue operations (doctor system, two paramedics or paramedic and nurse system)







Medical Emergency Teams

Air Ambulance (HEMS):

- -3 person: physican of System, paramedic or nurse, pilot
- -Only for critic sinations

- Emergency Medical Technician
 - ✓ new medical profession

Medical Emergency

Emergency Departments (ED).

"provide health care services consisting the initial diagnosis and treatment as necessary to stabilize the vital signs of people who are in a state of sudden health threat".

September 8, 2006 enforced the "Law on the State Emergency Medical Services ."












System nurse

is a nurse with the title of specialist in :

emergency nursing, anesthesia and intensive care, surgery, cardiology, pediatrics,

as well as a nurse who has completed a qualifying course in the field of emergency nursing, anesthesia and intensiva care, surgery, cardiology, pediatrics,

and having at least 3 years work experience in the branches of these specialties, emergency department, emergency rooms or ambulance service.



Medical Rescuer

(Paramedic, Emergency Medical Technician) a graduate from (specialty) medical emergency and holds a diploma certifying the professional title "paramedic".
