Outbreak Investigation Workshop

Background:

The workshop will take participants through a real outbreak related to chemical contamination of food. We will go over the development of a case definition, clinical toxidrome assessment, a surveillance tool, laboratory confirmation, an exposure questionnaire and a case control studies. We will also go over communication of risk to the public and publication of the results of the investigation.

Objectives:

- 1. Prepare for field work
- 2. Establish the existence of an outbreak
- 3. Verify the diagnosis
- 4. Construct a working case definition
- 5. Find cases systematically and record information
- 6. Perform descriptive epidemiology
- 7. Develop hypotheses
- 8. Evaluate hypotheses epidemiologically
- 9. As necessary, reconsider, refine, and re-evaluate hypotheses
- 10. Compare and reconcile with laboratory and/or environmental studies
- 11. Implement control and prevention measures
- 12. Initiate or maintain surveillance
- 13. Communicate findings

Recognition & Initial Management of an Illness Cluster (RIMIC)

February 22, 2020

Background: Emergency providers and first responders are not familiar with the assessment and management of patients injured by or exposed to a chemical, biological or radiological agents. Although these incidents are relatively infrequent, they can have disastrous consequences and pose serious challenges to the healthcare system and clinical providers. In order to mount an effective response while maintaining provider safety, basic principles should be followed. These principles include appreciation of important agent-event-victim characteristics, toxidrome recognition and management, and proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and performance of decontamination when necessary.

Objectives:

- 1- Discuss properties of chemicals, radioactive materials and biological agents that determine the clinical hazard
- 2- Recognize major chemical, biological and radiological syndromes
- 3- Initiate management of patients with major syndromes
- 4- Don level C PPE
- 5- Receive and manage a patient contaminated with chemicals or radioactive materials
- 6- Receive and decontaminate a patient contaminated with radioactive materials

Description:

The course content is based on the core principle of recognizing potential chemical, biological, and radiological injuries when assessing an undifferentiated patient or cluster of illness. The didactic component approached these hazards and illnesses based on the major organs systems with clinical manifestations (skin, respiratory tract, GI tract and central nervous system). The practical session introduce important principles of emergency department preparedness such as the Emergency Treatment Area, use of personal protective equipment, reception of a patient contaminated with chemicals or radioactive materials, radiation contamination survey and decontamination.
