CAUSES OF VIOLENCE (HCP BASED)


- Inadequate communication skills
- Poor education about anger management
- Not enough inform patient relatives
- Can not establish empathy\_
- Not suitable for place he/she is working
- Leaving first year resident in fast track
- Consultant doctors careless approach





# CAUSES OF VIOLENCE (POPULATION AND POLITICS BASED)

- Violence is a way of problem solving
- Hostile attitude of media
- Publishing a doctors failure like all doctors fault
- Changing the doctors place in population
- Inadequate alcohol and drug addicts rehab
- Inadequate geriatric care
- Unsatisfying punishments to violence crime to HCP
